All General Rules and Regulations apply to this section.

ENTRY DEADLINE: July 2, 2010

REFUNDABLE ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per member per project animal will be charged. Entry fees will be refunded for all entries that are shown.

PRIZE MONEY: will be allocated to the club instead of the individual members with the following pay structure (excluding Herdsmanship, Educational Display and Beef Team Fitting): \$10.00 per participating member per project.

REGULATIONS GOVERNING 4-H COMPETITIONS

1. Classes are open to boys and girls from invited clubs properly enrolled in the current 4-H program. The age restrictions are 9 - 19 as of January 1, 2010.
2. Entries must be made on "4-H Entry Forms".
3. Where applicable, all 4-H project Rules and Regulations apply to this Division.
4. Members must exhibit their own 4-H projects.
5. All entries will be checked for proper identification against those records filed in the 4-H Specialist's office. Improperly identified or substituted animals will be disallowed.
6. Interclub entries are limited to one per exhibiting club.
7. Agrifair will supply all shavings. STRAW IS PROHIBITED.
8. Judging will be by the Danish System for livestock projects and showmanship. Interclub and Herdsmanship shall be straight-line placings from first to last of prizes offered.
9. There must be at least two clubs competing in Interclub competitions
10. Each exhibitor can only show current year projects.
11. No exhibitors are allowed to sleep in the barn but are allowed to sleep in campers (in designated parking) only if adult supervision is provided.
12. Any clipping and grooming of a 4-H project at Agrifair must be done by the member themselves. They may be assisted by another member of the club, who fits into the age restrictions of 9 - 19. There is ZERO tolerance for ex-4-H members, leaders, parents or otherwise. This will result in disqualification of the animal.
13. Loading of trucks is NOT PERMITTED on the fairgrounds until release time of such projects. The Entry Office will assign load out time.
14. Members must show their projects in the Showmanship class in order to show in Project classes.
15. Show Committee and Agrifair officials have the right to deem any club member and/or leader unfit to be involved in shows based on their attitude, actions, and over all conduct.
16. There will be no tolerance for animal movement through the tunnel during the fair and especially not during move-in or move-out.
17. Each club may enter one Educational Display, Abbotsford 4-H clubs are exempt from this rule.

4-H HERDSMANSHIP SECTION - 2200



All clubs are automatically entered in the Herdsmanship Competition sponsored by:

PLEASE NOTE: Judging will take place between 12:00pm and 7:00pm daily on the days that your project is attending the fair. The following is the criteria the judges will be looking for:

IDENTIFICATION 10 Points

Clubs should be identified by appropriate signage. Members' projects should have informative signage (e.g. nametags, photos, breed type).

STALLS 10 Points

Should have adequate bedding, tidiness and cleanliness is expected.

ANIMALS 10 Points

Are to be kept tied, penned or caged appropriately and kept clean and groomed at all times.

EQUIPMENT, FEED, SUPPLIES 10 Points

Equipment and supplies should be kept neat and orderly. Contents and condition of boxes will not be considered. Boxes may be kept closed during scoring. Feed supplies are to be kept orderly and feed containers are to be kept clean.

ALLEYWAYS 10 Points

Should be kept free and clear of obstacles so public can pass.

EXHIBITORS 10 Points

Club members should display courtesy and politeness to the public. Members should be neat and their conduct above reproach.

PRESENTATION 20 Points

Clubs should include the present year fair theme "*Old...New...Growing with YOU!!*" Celebrating our 100th FAIR! in their decorations.

INFORMATION 20 Points

Clubs should display or have available for the public information on 4-H, agriculture or their 4-H projects (e.g. posters, photographs or handouts).

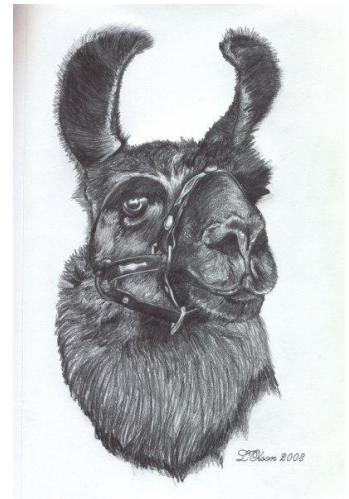
