

DIVISION A - BEEF CATTLE

All General Rules and Regulations apply to this section.

JUDGE:

ENTRY DEADLINE: Friday July 2, 2010

PLEASE NOTE: Late entries received after July 2, 2010 but before July 19, 2010 will be accepted at *double entry fee* per entry per class. NO late entries will be accepted after July 19, 2010.

MOVEIN/MOVE OUT: All exhibits must move into place after 10:00 pm Saturday July 31, 2010 to set up their respective areas. Animals must be moved into the fair before 8:00 am on Sunday, August 1, 2010. Move out time will be after 5:00 pm on Monday, August 2, 2010.

If release times need to be altered, special consideration may be given to those requesting IN WRITING at time of registration early release to catch a ferry to Vancouver Island or travel in excess of 300 km.

Twelve (12) animals will be allowed from a breeding unit if the two (2) additional entries are 4-H exhibits from the breeding unit shown by members of 4-H. Such additional exhibits will not be eligible to compete in the Breeder's Herd class. It is the responsibility of the 4-H member to provide written verification from his/her leader or Agriculture office that the entry is his/her "bona-fid" 4-H project for the year. These 4-H animals should be identified as such on the entry form.

Each breed must be shown separately and have at least:

1. Four (4) exhibitors per breed.
2. A minimum of 18 entries per breed.

A representative from each breed must be responsible for entry processing prior to the show, which includes handling of registration papers and checking tattoos. Only the birth date need be posted and worn visibly on the person showing the animals.

All animals (including calves) being shown in classes must be Canadian registered and tattooed 30 days prior to the entry closing date (**July 2, 2010**). **Calves must be properly tattooed (fresh tattoos are not acceptable).**

REGISTRATION PAPERS MUST BE PRODUCED AT THE SHOW OR ENTRY CANNOT BE SHOWN. ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.

Calves shown with their dam may also be entered in individual calf classes. If a heifer calf's dam becomes Champion or Reserve Senior Champion, that heifer calf is ineligible for the calf class, and entry fees will be refunded. Cows will show as a unit with their calves' in-group classes, or the calf may be shown alone.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR AND BREEDER:

Ribbons will be awarded for each breed shown. Points will be awarded as follows on the exhibitor's top 5 placings:

Points: 1st – 10 Points; 2nd – 8 Points; 3rd – 6 Points; 4th – 4 Points; 5th – 2 Points



OPEN BEEF ALL BREED PEN SHOW SECTION 100

ENTRY FEE: \$50.00 per entry on official entry form

PRIZE MONEY: 50% of entries go to first place and onto championship round; 30% goes to second place.

Cattle must be quiet and kept clean at all times. Cattle deemed wild or not unclean will be sent home and forfeit their entry fee as well as any prize money they may have won. Cattle are judged in their pens.

CLASSES:

1. Pair of calendar year Bull calves
2. Pair of calendar year Heifer calves
3. Pair of Yearling Heifers
4. Cow-Calf pair can be 2 years old or a mature cow with her natural 2010 calf at side

Jr. JACKPOT YEARLING HEIFER SHOW SECTION 200

ENTRY FEE: \$50.00 per entry on official entry form

PRIZE MONEY: 1st 40%; 2nd 30%; 3rd 10%

The age limit for exhibitors is a minimum of 9 years, maximum of 21 years in the calendar years. No requirement for junior membership, but Junior must own animal(s) shown or be owned by the family farm.

Open Yearling Heifer Show, including crossbreds, born January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009. Females entered as purebreds must supply registration papers at time of entry processing and be identified by name.

Jr. JACKPOT STEER SHOW SECTION 300

ENTRY FEE: \$50.00 per entry on official entry form

PRIZE MONEY: 1st 40%; 2nd 30%; 3rd 10%

The age limit for exhibitors is a minimum of 9 years, maximum of 21 years in the calendar years. No requirement for junior membership, but Junior must own animal(s) shown or be owned by the family farm.

Open Steer Show - no kill. Open to all exhibitors and 4-H members. All breeds are eligible to show.

CLASS:

1. Jackpot Steer Show

HEREFORD SHOW SECTION 400

SPONSORED BY: Murphy Ridge Farms, Peter Herefords, South Alder Farms, North Bluff Farms & Kootenay Polled Herefords.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per animal or group entry

PRIZE MONEY: 1st - \$80.00; 2nd - \$70.00; 3rd - \$55.00 for the exception of Get of Sire and Produce of Dam.

CLASSES:

If there are over 10 entries per class, the classes will be split into two groups by age, and prize money will be paid to both classes.

1. Bull Calf: Born in 2010. If there are over 10 entries, the class will be split into two groups by age, and prize money will be paid to both classes.
2. Yearling Bull: Born January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009.
3. Two year old Bull: Born January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008.

4. Heifer Calf: Born in 2010. If there are over 10 entries, the class will be split into two groups by age, and prize money will be paid to both classes.
5. Yearling Heifer: Born January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009. If there are more than 10 entries, the class will be split into two groups by age, and prize money will be paid to both classes.
6. Two year old cows with calf at side: Born January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008.
7. Mature cow with calf at side
8. Get of Sire – 3 animals from the same sire can be any age and sex. Animals can come from different breeding units.
9. Produce of Dam – 2 calves from the same dam can be any age and sex. Animals can come from different breeding Units.

HEREFORD CALF CHALLENGE

SECTION 500

A three-year class is being offered for Hereford females born the property of a B.C. breeder. Starting as a calf, the same animal is shown for 3 consecutive years (calf, yearling heifer, and cow/calf). Points will be awarded each year with double points being awarded for the cow/calf year. Winners are awarded according to the total points for 3 years. E.g., class of 2007 will show as calves in 2005. All entries must be shown in regular classes.

ENTRY FEE: Automatically Entered

PRIZE MONEY: Entry fees and a minimum sponsorship of \$1,000.00 will be paid out: 1st-40%; 2nd-20%; 3rd-10%; 4th-10%; 5th-6%; 6th-6%; 7th-4%; 8th-4% in the 3rd year.
